- Ipads/digital devices must not be used for accessing illicit or offensive material.
- Ipads/digital devices must not be used to defame, threaten, abuse, bully, harass any individual, group or organisation.
- Ipads/digital devices should not be used for audio, photo or video recording without prior knowledge and consent of those being recorded and the supervising teacher.
- Ipads/digital devices must not be used to violate copyright.
- Crana College will retain full ownership of any device it supplies unless the device has been fully paid for by a third party.
- Crana College reserves the right to alter the software and hardware options available on any device that is used for educational purposes.
- Ipads/digital devices must not be altered or jail broken in order to circumvent any security or policy settings.
- Crana College reserves the right to inspect any device to ensure that it complies with its ICT policy.
- All devices *must* be covered with adequate insurance including accidental damage.
- All devices should be fitted with robust protective covers at all times.
- It is the responsibility of the student to have the device fully charged at the beginning of each day.
- Students are not permitted to use cellular networks in schools or centres.
 SIM cards must be removed from the devices before being used in the schools or centres.

• All students *must* return any school provided devices and accessories in a similar condition to that when it was received, when requested to do so.
